Zúrich. El apóstol Shadreck Mundia Lubasi será el nuevo apóstol de distrito ayudante para África del este. En noviembre el apóstol mayor Wilhelm Leber realizará este acto en el servicio divino en Dar-es-Salaam (Tanzania). Será un primer paso para crear una nueva área de apóstol de distrito que debe crecer en los próximos años, informa el apóstol mayor. Esto incluye los países Kenia, Tanzania y Uganda.

El apóstol mayor Leber informó primero a los apóstoles que viven en estos países o están en actividades misioneras. La iglesia aspira una mayor independencia de las iglesias regionales en África dentro del marco de la estrategia de la iglesia.
