



Zúrich/Hamburgo. A fines de mayo el jefe internacional de la Iglesia Nueva Apostólica, el apóstol mayor Dr. Wilhelm Leber, visita la iglesia regional Alemania del norte para la fiesta de Pentecostés de este año. Con él se esperan a más de 60 apóstoles del interior y del extranjero europeo. El motivo será el servicio divino en Centro de Congresos de Hamburgo (CCH). **Pentecost divine service of the New Apostolic Church  
on Sunday, 27 May 2007**

Zürich/Hamburg. At the end of May, the international leader of the New Apostolic Church, Chief Apostle Wilhelm Leiber, will visit the Holy Church of Mother Germany for his year's feast of Pentecost. Over 50 Apostles from 16th Europe and the countries served from Europe are expected to attend the anniversary with him. The largest will be the divine service in the Hamburg-Cathedral, which will be broadcasted to 20 countries, such as South Africa, White Russia, Via-Saint region, and the Nordic countries by satellite. The service will be transmitted to all continents.

A European Apostles Meeting is scheduled to take place over the days preceding Pentecost. The Apostles will discuss topics that are especially of importance to the Church, such as their daily pastoral mission. A similar has been conducted in the Hamburg-Cathedral. The members of the large Hamburg churches and parishes that have already been preparing for the special performance for this occasion. The very presence of the head chief for the New Apostolic Church are also practicing diligently already. In addition, the children's choir, musicians, and some individual artists have also been preparing themselves for the occasion.

Numerous preparations, both large and small, are still underway. Here are just a few of them: writing invitations, designing greeting and distribution cards, preparing with conditions official, setting up a special website for ongoing reporting, ensuring the technical needs are met, looking into the possibility of organizing transportation, and much more.

The multilingual Pentecost experience broadcast in national times will also be the modern step which in that the invited guests from across Europe will all be speaking their French, Italian, Portuguese, Spanish, German, or Greek mother tongue.
