Zurich. A meeting with Cardinal Kurt Koch, president of the Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity, was on the agenda of the New Apostolic Work Group "Contacts with other Denominations and Religions" as they visited Rome. The discussion partners discussed matters of mutual interest for a good hour. The New Apostolic Church is thereby continuing its dialogue with the Catholic Church.

Once the Catechism of the New Apostolic Church has been published, the discussion partners plan to meet up again. Back in 2008 the group had already met with Cardinal Walter Casper, then the Vatican's designated contact person for ecumenical matters.
